Technology Conditions Surveys (TCS)

Overview

A [Technology Conditions Survey](#) (TCS) assesses the condition of all of a district's technology infrastructure including pathways, cables, Technology Rooms (network rooms/closets) and systems in some or all buildings. The resulting baseline of information can be used as the basis for a Comprehensive Technology Plan (CTP).

Technology systems surveyed include:

- **Structured Cabling:** Paths and Spaces from edge-of-property entrance facilities to Technology Rooms (TRs)
- **Communications:** Phone, Network and Wireless Access
- **Distributed AV:** Public Address, Master Clock and Mass Notification
- **Classroom:** Presentation and Learning technologies
- **Security:** Video Surveillance, Access Control and Intrusion Detection systems

Services Include

- Conducting Technology Conditions Surveys (TCSs) of all or select district buildings including non-instructional facilities.
- Meeting with district staff and representatives including Facilities and IT departments and Architects of Record (AOR) to solicit input.
- Preparing a report summarizing the results of the surveys in each building with recommendations on what portions can be used as is, with refurbishment/upgrades or in need of replacements.

Deliverables Include

- Technology Conditions Survey Report (PDF format)
- Executive Summary Google® Slide deck
- Presentation of Executive Summary to district and AOR representatives
