


NYS Smart School Investment Planning Process Timeline





What is it? Passage of New York State's *Smart School Bond Act* in November 2014 provides an opportunity for School Districts across the State to fund technology upgrades. Districts must develop and submit a *Smart School Investment Plan (SSIP)* for State approval to receive their allocations. ([Find](#) your District's allocated funding.)


What do District officials need to do? As part of the planning process, Districts must gather input from stakeholders — teachers, students, parents, community—prior to submission of the final SSIP to the State Education Department (SED) for review and approval. The graphic below shows a model timeline for *SSIP* development that addresses key milestones required by the SED.
