
## Building Conditions Surveys vs. Technology Conditions Surveys: Systems Surveyed

Conducted every five years, a NYSED-mandated Building Conditions Survey (BCS) assesses the physical conditions of a district's Architectural, Mechanical, Electrical and Plumbing (AMEP) systems. It does not, however, include the technology infrastructure and related IP-based systems that move and use data throughout the district.

Conducted by Registered Communications Distribution Designers (RCDDs), MasterLibrary Professional Services' <u>Technology Conditions Surveys</u> (TCS) objectively assess the current conditions of a district's technology systems, and provides recommended improvements to meet district goals with a Rough Order of Magnitude budget for the recommendations. These findings create the foundation for the development of a district-wide, ten-year <u>Comprehensive Technology Plan</u> (CTP).
