
COVID RELIEF EDUCATION FUNDING BY THE NUMBERS

Between the three Covid economic relief acts passed since March 2020, there is a total of about **\$193 billion** available to help K12 public and private schools reopen to in-person learning and to help students make up for the past year.




MARCH 2021 AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN EDUCATION FUNDING

The most recent of three Covid relief package in 12 months, the American Rescue Plan earmarks about **\$123 billion** for K12 public schools to mitigate the learning effects of the pandemic including in-person instruction.




2020-'21 TOTAL COVID RELIEF EDUCATION FUNDING
